COMMUNITY SERVICE THROUGH LIBERTY

Lutheran Disaster Response – Eastern PA, a program of Liberty Lutheran, helps meet long term disaster related needs of households that face the greatest barriers to recovery. Some of these barriers include:

- Insufficient resources to make necessary repairs for heating systems, damaged drywall, and insulation.
- ·No access to the internet.
- ·Lacking a family support network.
- ·Cognitive impairments.



We are currently serving communities in six counties in eastern Pennsylvania, including the Pennview Mobile Home Park in Berks County. Pennview residents were hit by heavy storms in July 2023. Rains overwhelmed the Antietam Creek and sent several feet of water through the trailer park. The insulation beneath the trailers as well as the skirting around the bottom were ruined. Many of the insurance policies that residents carried did not cover these repairs. Therefore, LDR and our partners are working with donated funding and volunteer labor to replace insulation and skirting, one trailer at a time.


