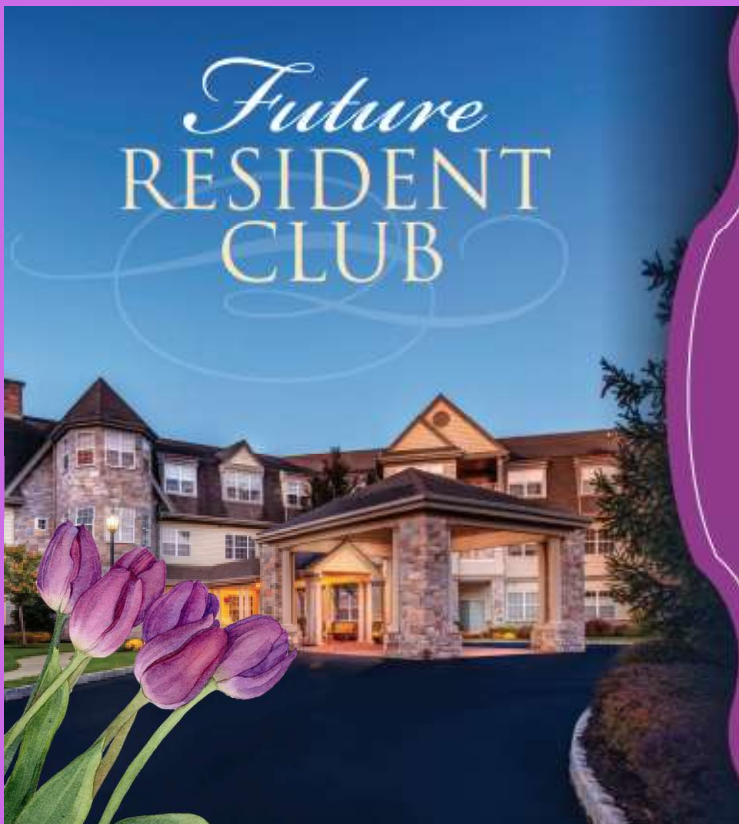

Book Clubs

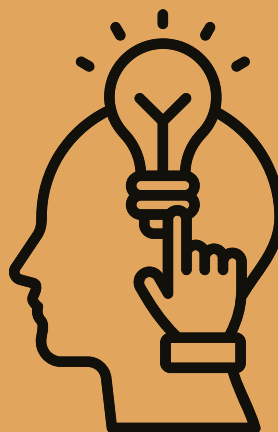
