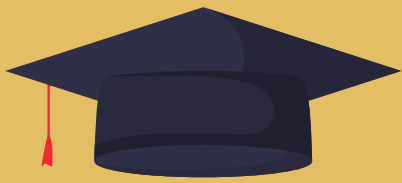

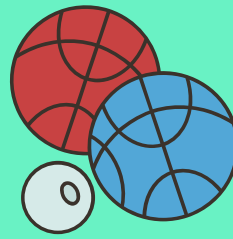
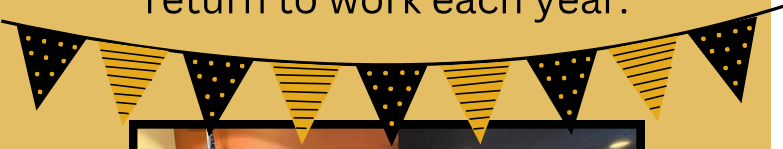
Bob, the son of Manor residents Bob & Louise M., took us on a photographic journey of his climb to the base camp at Mt. Everest.
